Description of Project

Heritage Orangeville has established an annual Heritage Community Recognition Awards program to recognize owners of Orangeville’s heritage resources. The Heritage Community Recognition Award recognizes, promotes and encourages the preservation, ongoing maintenance, restoration, rehabilitation, renovation and/or adaptive re-use of heritage properties. The award will honour one homeowner who has invested considerable time, effort, resources and care into their property.

Who is Eligible?

Residents of the Town of Orangeville

How is the recipient selected?

Heritage Orangeville will select a recipient of the award based on the award criteria.

Award Criteria

- respect for original building features and materials
- maintenance and/or restoration of heritage attributes
- sympathetic adaptation to contemporary use/standards
- use of high quality materials and high degree of craftsmanship
- general enhancement of neighbourhood/community
