By-law Number 2021-

A by-law to authorize the use of Optical Scanning Vote Tabulators and a Vote at Home Program in the 2022 Municipal and School Board Election

Whereas section 42(1) of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended, provides that a local municipality may pass by-laws authorizing the use of voting and vote-counting equipment;

And whereas section 42(1) further provides that a local municipality may pass by-laws authorizing electors to use an alternative voting method that does not require electors to attend at a voting place in order to vote;

And whereas the Town of Orangeville intends to utilize optical scanning vote tabulators and to implement a vote at home program during the 2022 municipal and school board election;

Now therefore be it resolved that the Council for The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the use of optical scanning vote tabulators for the purpose of counting votes is hereby authorized for the 2022 municipal and school board election.
2. That a vote at home program be implemented for homebound electors who are unable to attend a voting place without unreasonable difficulty (due to illness, injury or disability).

Read three times and finally passed this 26th day of April, 2021.
