



The Corporation of the Town of Orangeville
By-law Number
A by-law to amend Traffic By-law 78-2005

Whereas the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c.25, S.11, authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws respecting matters within the jurisdiction of highways including traffic and speeding limits on highways; and

Whereas Council deems it expedient to amend By-law No. 78-2005, as amended;

Now therefore be it resolved that Council of the Corporation of the Town of Orangeville hereby enact as follows:

1. That Schedule "A" (No Parking Where Signs Posted on Highway) of By-law 78-2005, be amended by deleting the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Side</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>Column 4</u> <u>Times</u>
Hurontario Street	West	Entrance to Island Lake Conservation Area to a Point of 100 metres southerly thereof	Any Time

2. That Schedule "A" (No Parking Where Signs Posted on Highway) of By-law 78-2005, be amended by adding the following:

<u>Column 1</u> <u>Highway</u>	<u>Column 2</u> <u>Side</u>	<u>Column 3</u> <u>Between</u>	<u>Column 4</u> <u>Times</u>
Hurontario Street	West Side	From Conservation Area Entrance, southerly Approximately 300 metres	Any Time
