And that Council pass a By-law to appoint Megan Archer, Caroline Godsend, Meridith Edney and Rachel Noonan as Animal Control Officers for the purpose of enforcing the Town's Animal Control By-law.

Background and Analysis

On June 27, 2005 the Town entered into a Service Agreement with the Ontario Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (OSPCA) which has been extended every four years with the most recent extension expiring December 31, 2022 as authorized by By-law 025-2019. This Service Agreement provides for the OSPCA to provide animal control services to the Town.

The OSPCA has advised that Megan Archer, Caroline Godsend, Meridith Edney and Rachel Noonan provide animal control enforcement services to the Town. The Town must pass a By-law to give them the authority as Animal Control Officers to enforce the Town's Animal Control By-law.
