- **Proclamation name, details and event information**
I'm writing to you in preparation for this year's Woman Abuse Prevention Month; an annual event that takes place throughout the month of November, across Ontario. Family Transition Place (FTP) would like to request your participation in this year's provincial Wrapped in Courage Campaign, which takes place in conjunction with—and in support of—Woman Abuse Prevention Month.

FTP is a not-for-profit organization that provides vital services and support for survivors of gender-based violence and their children including emergency shelter, counselling, transitional support, outreach and education. FTP is a proud agency partner of the provincial Wrapped in Courage 2021 campaign, which has been raising awareness related to gender-based violence in Ontario for the past eight years.

November 25th marks both the International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women and the first day of the 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence worldwide. We request that the Town of Orangeville will consider proclaiming November 25th as the International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women and raising a Wrapped in Courage flag on November 25th to raise awareness and promote gender equality. The flags are 36" x 72" in size and feature a campaign symbol and text (End Gender-Based Violence).
