### **Recommendations**

**And that Council consider a by-law authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to sign an Amending Agreement with the Ministry of Transportation.**

### **Background and Analysis**

The Province and the Town of Orangeville entered into the Ontario Municipal Commuter Cycling (“OMCC”) Program Transfer Payment Agreement on March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2018. The funding from this program was used to cover the costs of various Town projects that dealt with cycling trails.

The remaining project under this agreement is the Blind Line and Broadway Crossing and Trails. Due to many factors, this project has been significantly delayed and the Ministry has granted an extension request for the Town of Orangeville. The previous end date was December 30, 2021 which has now been extended to July 1, 2022 and will give the Town sufficient time to complete this project.
